**Narcissus Split Corona, Collar Division Daffodil.** Exquisite white, broad perianth overlaid with a softly-ruffled yellow corona, split skirt that is striped, streaked, and frilled such that it has a sunburst effect resembling the appearance of a butterfly. 12-16 inches high, with each stem bearing two of these unusual, 3-inch FRAGRANT blooms mid-season (April-May). Showy daffodil for mass plantings. Excellent for picking, always a highlight in arrangements. Prefers full sun to partial shade, hardy in Zones 2-10. This beauty can also be potted in containers as a forced bulb, making wonderful gifts for family and friends during the holidays and winter season.
