

Garden 1: Located in the heart of the Historic District, this little garden room is packed with charm. Perched on a bank high above the Androscoggin, this would be the perfect place for summer dining.... or to enjoy a coffee.

Garden 2: Just across the street from Garden #1 in the Historic District, this magnificent yard is a must see. A vine draped pergola sets the tone. All gardens are a work in progress. In this garden, there has been a lot of work, and a lot of progress. Visitors will leave feeling inspired.

Garden 3: Where to begin... the majestic Cedar tree, the heirloom Seckel Pears with their contorted bark? Every year this homeowner asks himself, "Can I fit just one more plant here?" The answer is yes. If one were to see a fairy, it would be in this garden, also in the Historic District.

Garden 4: This lovely Foreside Road farm was settled in 1717 and it remains a working farm. During the year you can purchase fresh eggs and vegetables here. The truly impressive vegetable garden comes with a bonus, sweeping views of the Androscoggin.

Garden 5: On the Cathance Road, another very historic area of Topsham, with a truly lovely yard and garden. This is a must see.

This is a self-guided tour. It will be held rain or shine. No rain date, no refunds.

Tickets are \$10 each. Children 10 and under may attend free of charge. Attendees must have ticket in hand to be granted admission to the gardens.
