

Note: Please make arrangements to carpool and meet at the Topsham Home Depot, Park n Ride, no later than 11:15. Driving time is approximately 40 minutes.

Directions: From I-95 North: Take the new Augusta/Belfast Exit # 113. Proceed east straight through traffic light and over the new bridge crossing the Kennebec River. After the bridge, at the traffic light, turn right onto Route 201 South. Follow signs to Augusta. Take the 3rd exit off the Cony Rotary onto Stone Street (Route 9). Go up hill and straight through the traffic lights. The turn to the Arboretum's Visitors Center is approximately 0.7 mile past the lights on the left. **Restrooms are in the building.** Side gate will be open, drive up the dirt road to Johnson Outdoor Learning Center a half mile from the visitors Center. **The stairs going down into the center are a little steep so that might be a concern for those with physical limitations. (You should be fine with appropriate shoes and walking stick)**
