

## **“Change Beneath Our Feet” with Barry Logan on February 11**



Bowdoin College professor Barry Logan will speak to the Topsham Garden Club on the topic of “*Change Beneath Our Feet: The Ecological History and Prospects of Midcoast Maine.*” Logan studies plant responses to environmental stress throughout North America from Alaska to the Florida panhandle.

Last year, with Frank Goodyear, Jennifer Pye, and others, he co-curated the popular exhibit, “Art, Ecology, and the Resilience of a Maine Island: The Monhegan Wildlands” seen at the Bowdoin College Museum of Art and the Monhegan Museum of Art & History.

Logan has taught at Bowdoin College since 1998 and is frequently invited to address professional gatherings and community groups, including the Topsham Garden club where, in 2020, he spoke about his work on Monhegan Island.

The talk is open to the public and will begin at 12:00 Noon on Wednesday, February 11, at the Topsham Public Library, 125 Foreside Road. The public is welcome to stay afterwards to socialize with Topsham Garden Club members over a bring-your-own brown-bag lunch. Dessert and coffee will be provided by the club.
